ROGER

(monotone voice)

Hello, welcome to Gooder Grocers, how are you doing today?

The little boy places a pack of bubble gum on the conveyor belt.

LITTLE BOY

Um. I'm good.

ROGER

(monotone)

That's good to hear s-

LITTLE BOY

(shouting a little too loudly)

How are you?

From here on out, Roger speaks in a monotone emotionless voice.

ROGER

Fine, thanks.

Roger places the bubble gum in a brown paper bag and hands it to the little boy.

ROGER

Have a nice day.

The little boy leaves and a teen boy waits impatiently behind him. He is dressed in all black with earbuds in.

ROGER

Hello, welcome to Gooder Grocers, how are you doing today?

The teen takes an earbud out.

TEEN BOY

What?

ROGER

Hello, welcome to Gooder Grocers, how are you doing today?

TEEN BOY

Fine.

The teen boy places a lighter, a candy bar, and an energy drink on the conveyor belt.

ROGER

That's good to hear sir.

TEEN BOY

Pack of cigarettes too.

ROGER

I'll need your I.D.

TEEN BOY

It's just a pack.

ROGER

Sir, I can not give it to you unless you are over the age of eighteen.

TEEN BOY

I am.

ROGER

I.D. please.

TEEN BOY

Forget the lighter then.

ROGER

Have a nice day sir.

TEEN BOY

ROGER

ROGER

MAN

MAN

ROGER

MAN

Yep. Yep it will.

ROGER

May I see your I.D. sir?

MAN

Oh, what for?

ROGER

The wine and the medication.

MAN

Wow. I haven't been carded in...well I don't know how long. Go right ahead.

The man gives Roger his license. Roger looks at it, then does a double take and looks again eyes wide open.
