SOPHIE

Bela, she's a teacher, we're gonna see her as soon as school starts.

BELA

Well, for now, she's forgotten. I mean, it's our last summer before we graduate and I intend to live these moments to the fullest. Even if it means calling out teachers for their year-round torment.

Sophie laughs.

SOPHIE

You're willing to throw away your future for some impulsive decisions just because it's senior year?

BELA

It's not an impulsive decision, it's... a calculated risk. I don't want this summer to end with any regrets.

Bela and Sophie lock eyes. There's something there.

Sophie looks away first.

SOPHIF

Alright. So what will be your next "calculated risk" then?

CUT TO:

3 INT. BELA'S HOUSE - EVENING

BELA

SHE TEXTED ME SHE TEXTED ME! OH MY GOD SHE TEXTED ME!

SOPHIE

Geez, you guys really hit it off huh?

BELA

I don't know, I thought I wasn't her type to be honest, but she said "I had a really nice time talking to you today."

Sophie looks unimpressed.

SOPHIE

That's it? She seems realllyyyy interested.

BELA

Oh that doesn't matter. What matters is that she texted me. Which means I have a date this weekend.

Bela types a quick text and sends it.

SOPHIE

How do you know she's even free this weekend?

Bela gets a message "DING."

BELA

Because she just agreed to a date this Saturday.

SOPHIE

Oh, well... I'm happy for you.

BELA

Thank you. Now I just need to find something to wear.

Bela heads back to her room.

Sophie pulls the book from underneath her. She tosses it to the ground, confused why she was ever reading it, and walks away.

4 EXT. RESTAURANT - AFTERNOON

6 INT. BELA'S LIVING ROOM - EVENING

7 EXT. RESTAURANT - AFTERNOON

Bela and Izzy are having a screaming match outside the restaurant. It's their first big fight.

Sophie glances up at them from her car, but looks back down immediately. Izzy storms to her car and gets in.

8 INT. SOPHIE'S ROOM - DAY

Bela is angrily texting Izzy on her phone. Sophie reads a new book next to her on the bed. They're in PJ's again.

Next, Bela is pacing the room, talking about the fight. Sophie sits in the same spot listening to her.

9 INT. SOPHIE'S ROOM - NIGHT

CONTINUOUS WITH LAST SCENE. SAME PJ'S.

Sophie sits in the same spot as Bela cries in her arms. Sophie holds her best friend and tries to support her.

Music fades out.

BELA

I just wish she understood me.

SOPHIE

You don't think she does?

BELA

Not like you do.

Sophie looks down at Bela's head. Does Bela even know how much that means to her? Probably not, she really needs to figure out her feelings.

Music begins playing again.

10 EXT. BELA'S PORCH - DAY

Bela is crying while talking to Izzy on their front porch. Izzy breaks up with Bela. Izzy walks away. Bela runs into the house where Sophie waits for her with open arms.

END OF EXCERPT.

Synopsis: Bela and Sophie have been friends forever, but as their final summer together begins, feelings arise. But their journey outside of their friendship gets halted by Bela's new budding relationship. Sophie has to figure out her feelings before she loses her chance of love as summer passes.
